CELEBRATING ONE YEAR OF THE GOSPEL TRUTH NETWORK

I've been preaching the Gospel for more than fifty-five years. When I first started, I never planned to be on television—much less build a network. I'm grateful the Lord has opened doors for me to share the Gospel through various television outlets over the years.

Not long ago, two of the major networks we are on began questioning some of my teaching. I'm not planning to stop broadcasting on those networks, but it made me realize how fragile my connection with them really is. A contract can be canceled with just thirty days' notice. My whole life is about taking the Gospel as far and as deep as possible, and I wasn't willing to risk being shut off just because someone didn't like what I said.

As I sought the Lord about it, He showed me exactly what to do: start our own network. I've never claimed to be the sharpest knife in the drawer, but I've learned in my walk with the Lord that when He tells you to do something, the only right answer is yes. When you do what He tells you, He provides the people, the resources, and the opportunities—and He gets all the glory. Amen!

That's how the Gospel Truth Network (GTN) began. On September 30, 2024, we launched GTN with one clear goal: to make the truth of the Gospel available 24/7—without censorship, without compromise.

We started with what we had. We took part of the parking garage at Charis Bible College and, in just three months, turned it into Studio C, complete with control rooms, sound booths, and dressing rooms. We also built five new sets, located in Studio C and

at the AWM headquarters studio. We hope to have a dedicated space for GTN in the next few years, but God gave us the grace to get it done with what was available—and you, our partners, made it possible.

One of the things I love about GTN is that it's more than just preaching. It's a full network with programs for every age and stage of life. We live in entertainment-driven times, so we're using that to reach and disciple people where they are. And it's working!

Here's a brief look at what God has done in just one year through GTN:

- **13.8M views on 1.1M individual devices**
- **310+ conference episodes filmed and aired**
- **184 unique guests** on *Grace & Faith Today*
- **100+ episodes each** of *Grace & Faith Today* and *Andrew's Classics*
- **200 episodes** of *Charis Daily* filmed by mid-July
- **259 episodes** of *Charis Unplugged* filmed by early May

These numbers aren't just statistics—they represent lives touched, hearts restored, and people finding hope again.

Why GTN Matters

How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

I know every teacher on GTN personally. They aren't just teachers; they're people who've been through hard times—trials, pain, and battles—and stood firm on God's promises. They've seen God come through (Rev. 12:11), and now they're sharing that same faith with you.

Jesus said in John 8:31–32, *"If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."* It's only the truth you know that sets you free. You've got to continue in God's Word if you're going to live in the victory Jesus won for you.

Looking Ahead

As we celebrate one year of GTN, I believe we're only just getting started. We have some exciting new productions on the horizon. This November, **Healing Stories** will premiere—a show that breathes new life into the cherished testimonies from our *Healing Journeys* videos. You'll really enjoy how those will be presented in a richer, more immersive way. And in January, I'll be launching *Through the Bible*, a brand-new series where I teach verse by verse through every scripture in the Bible. These programs are part of our ongoing mission to bring the Gospel to you in fresh, engaging ways.

The vision is bigger than us, and the impact will last for generations. Jesus said the harvest is great, but the laborers are few. Jamie and I are so thankful for every single person standing with us to bring it in. When you support this ministry, you're part of everything GTN does. You may never see the faces or hear the stories, but lives are changing every day because of you.

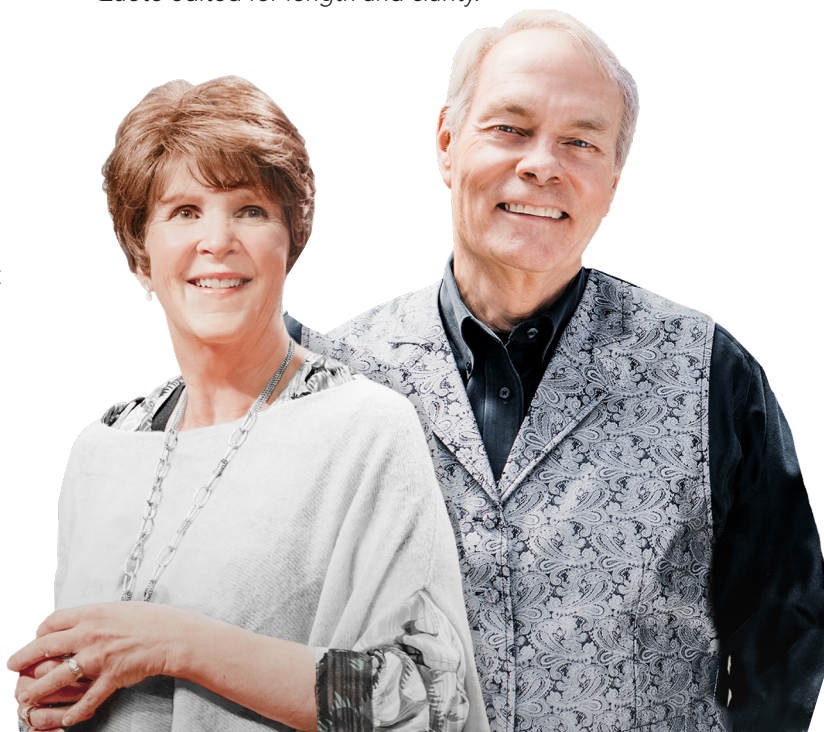

HOW TO BECOME A WATER WALKER

Have you ever wondered why some believers seem to walk in miracles while others don't? In *How to Become a Water Walker*, Andrew unpacks a familiar Bible story—Peter walking on the water—and shows that experiencing a miracle is not random. It's the result of hearing God's Word and acting on it.

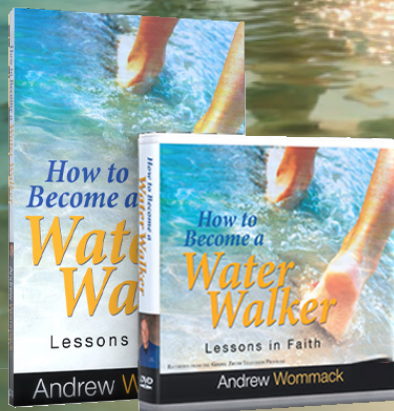
Peter's story begins with Jesus constraining the disciples to get into the boat and go to the other side (Matt. 14:22). The word *constrained* means to be compelled by force, suggesting that the disciples resisted—possibly because, as seasoned fishermen, they knew a storm was coming. Yet they obeyed, stepping into a situation contrary to their natural wisdom—and that's often where miracles begin.

Jesus' instruction was clear: go to the other side. Not go halfway and drown, but go to the other side. If the disciples had taken His word to heart, they could have rebuked the storm themselves. This is a key principle: before you can receive a miracle, you must be where God told you to be, doing what He told you to do.

When Jesus appeared, walking on the water, His first words were, "Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid" (Matt. 14:27). This was more than comfort—it was an invitation to use faith. Peter responded, "Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water" (Matt. 14:28). Out of twelve disciples, only one asked to do what Jesus was doing. God is no respecter of persons—every disciple could have walked on the water, but only Peter stepped out.

And then came the word that changed everything: "Come" (Matt. 14:29). One word from Jesus was enough to override natural laws. But Peter still had to leave the boat. Many pray for a miracle without ever taking that first step into the unknown. Fear keeps them clinging to safety, never placing themselves in a position where they need God to show up.

As Andrew often says, if your life isn't supernatural, it's superficial. Walking on water—whether literally or in your calling—starts with a clear word from God, followed by a willing heart to obey, even when it defies human reasoning. That's when you see His power at work.

Running the Race and Trusting God Along the Way

If you've ever tuned in to *Run Your Race* on the Gospel Truth Network, you're probably felt that easy, down-to-earth rhythm between Billy and Becky Epperhart. It's the kind of real talk that makes you feel like you're sitting with longtime friends who just happen to carry decades of wisdom. And maybe that's the secret to their impact. Because for Billy and Becky, who recently celebrated fifty years of marriage, this isn't just a show—it's a calling that's been decades in the making.

A Dream Reignited

Billy's journey to hosting *Run Your Race* began long before the launch of GTN. "Years ago, Becky and I were on a weekly television program in Denver," he shares. "Even back then, I could see us doing something more with it—but it wasn't the right time."

That changed about a year ago when the vision came back into focus. "GTN reignited that passion. Most people don't know I pastored for over twenty-eight years," he says. "We were senior pastors, did television in Denver and Louisiana, and even went to Africa in 2000 with James and Betty Robison. It all helped prepare us for now."

But it was a prophetic word—out of the blue, from a man who didn't know anything about Billy's collection of old sermon outlines—that confirmed it

was time to dust them off and step into a new season. "I went home and told Becky, 'That man had no way of knowing that I've been sitting on all that material!'" he laughs. "It was just one of those God moments that brought us confirmation when the opportunity came for us to host a show on GTN."

Why It Matters

For Billy, the heart of *Run Your Race* is simple: to remind people they matter, and God has a specific purpose for their lives. It's a message that's only grown more urgent with time. "Psalm 139:16 tells us God has written every day of our lives before we were born," he says. "We want viewers to know three things: You matter to God. Your purpose matters to God. And we want to encourage you to fulfill that purpose."

Becky plays a big role—both on-screen and off. "The ladies love her more than they love me," Billy jokes. "She brings the Word in a powerful, personal way. We bounce things off each other—it's real, it's fun, and it works."

Real Life, Real Ministry

Behind the scenes, the process of launching the show—and the Gospel Truth Network itself—has been no small feat. "Andrew Wommack gave us a deadline in January 2024 to be on air by September that same year," Billy says. "That was a big lift! But the entire ministry rose to the challenge, and we got it done."



It hasn't always been smooth. Life at AWM and Charis is full and fast-paced, especially for Billy, who also serves as CEO. "People ask how I balance it all. I joke that being CEO gives you all the free time in the world," he laughs. "But truthfully, there's a kaleidoscope of responsibilities. You have to pull from every emotional reserve week after week."

Even so, *Run Your Race* brings a different kind of energy. "This show allows Becky and me to pull from our life experiences and decades of ministry. It just flows out of who we are and all God has taught us."

For Such a Time as This

Billy believes GTN is uniquely positioned to speak into this cultural moment. "The beauty of GTN is that it brings Andrew's teachings and the voices of other trusted ministers directly into homes, 24/7," he says. "It's an extension of what we do at Charis Bible College. And during the limitations we all experienced during COVID, we realized just how powerful that kind of access really is."

He compares the variety of GTN hosts and programs to the flavors in an ice cream shop. "Vanilla may be the most popular, but I'm more of a rocky road and salted caramel guy," he smiles. "You've got to be yourself. Don't try to be someone else. God's called you for a reason, to reach the people *you're* called to reach."

And if he could say just one thing to every viewer tuning in? He doesn't hesitate: "Romans 8:31—If God is for you, who can be against you? That's what I want people to hear. Life has its challenges, but God is for you. That changes everything."

The Race Continues

Whether he's writing, teaching, leading, or hosting *Run Your Race*, Billy Epperhart is all in. He and Becky are living proof that no matter where you are in life, God's calling keeps you moving forward.
